PREPAREDNESS PLAN For Indoor Services

1. This list of protocols will be available to all congregants at the entrance as well as electronically via our website and facebook.

2. Pre-service measures:

- a. Indoor Service suggestions are for 250 or less attendees.
- b. Doors will remain propped open with the exception of bathrooms.
 - i. Bathrooms (especially handles and knobs) will be cleaned prior to and post service.
- c. Signage will also be placed reminding attendees about safe practices
- d. Signage will include warnings and information about symptomatic persons.
 - i. For example: *Symptoms of COVID-19 can include fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, headache, muscle pain, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell. Other less common symptoms include gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.*
- e. Community toys or shared objects have been removed from the seating area.
- f. GRAOG has chairs for seating. These chairs have been physically spaced for proper 6 feet of separation.
- g. Hand sanitizer stations are placed in the foyer and in the sanctuary by the sound board.
- h. According to the new orders (July 22nd) masks will be required for attendance. Masks will be available upon entering the building.
- i. Prior to a first meeting, the pre-service communication will warn any symptomatic individuals (Or those who suspect exposure) to stay home for 2-3 weeks before checking with the Pastor about possible attendance.
- j. All social distancing practices will be observed.
- k. If you don't feel well or have health concerns, please stay home and join us online at graog.com or on our Facebook page.

3. During Service:

- a. Doors open: 10:30am

- b. Services begins 11:00am
- c. Services will one hour or less to accommodate parents with children and also to lessen exposure time to any possible germs.
- d. Common areas will be closed and cautioned off with the exception of bathrooms.
- e. Financial gifts and offering will be given on the way out of the sanctuary post dismissal in a box. (No touch necessary)
 - i. Online giving is also available.
- f. All social distancing practices will be observed.

4. Other

- a. Until Aug 2020 (or possibly later), no wedding receptions will be held at GRAOG.
- b. Any other discipleship based meeting will follow the same structural protocols as the Sunday service.
- c. Use of the building during the week must be preapproved by the pastors and cleaning will be enforced after use.
