

2021 GRAOG COVID PREPAREDNESS PLAN

For Indoor Services

1. This list of protocols will be available to all congregants at the entrance as well as electronically via our website and facebook. (Updated 05/27/21)

2. Pre-service measures:

a. Masks are no longer required for those who have been fully vaccinated (2 weeks after the final dose of a vaccination). Masks are strongly encouraged for those who have not been vaccinated, and will be available upon entrance.

b. Pre-service communication will warn any symptomatic individuals (or those who suspect exposure) to please contact the Pastors and be directed to follow the current CDC guidelines, as these change frequently.

i. Signage will include warnings and information about symptomatic persons. For example: "Symptoms of COVID-19 can include fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, headache, muscle pain, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell. Other less common symptoms include gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea."

c. All social distancing practices will be observed.

d. GRAOG has chairs for seating. These chairs have been physically spaced for proper 6 feet of separation. Members of a household or groups of up to 10 may sit together, 6 feet apart from other groups/households.

e. Signage will also be placed reminding attendees about safe practices

f. Bathrooms (especially handles and knobs) will be cleaned prior to and post service.

g. Community toys or shared objects have been removed from the seating area.

h. Hand sanitizer stations are placed in the foyer and in the sanctuary by the sound board.

a. Doors open: 10:30 AM

- c. Service will be one hour or less to lessen exposure time to any possible germs.
- d. Financial gifts and offering will be given on the way out of the sanctuary post dismissal in a box. (No touch necessary)
- e. Online giving is also available.
- f. Communal food dining, including morning coffee and donuts will be addressed at a later date. Our hope is to be able to serve our coffee and donuts in the very near future.
- g. All social distancing practices will be observed.

4. Other

- a. Any other discipleship based meeting will follow the same structural protocols as the Sunday service.
- b. Use of the building during the week must be preapproved by the pastors and cleaning will be enforced after use.
